Introduction

2.2 Analytical/Performance Cookies

These cookies help us analyze how visitors use our website, allowing us to improve its functionality and user experience. For example, we may use tools like Google

Analytics, Facebook Pixel, and Yandex.Metrika to track user behavior. These cookies collect anonymous data to analyze user activity, such as:

- Time and date of visits:
- Repeat visits;
- Referring websites.

Each analytics service stores unique cookies that do not track visitors across multiple sites.

Legal Basis: These cookies require your explicit consent under GDPR (Article 6(1)(a)) and PIPEDA.

2.3 Functional Cookies

These cookies remember your preferences, such as language settings or login details, to provide a more personalized experience. They improve the user experience and are automatically deleted when you close your browser or session expires.

Legal Basis: These cookies require your explicit consent under GDPR (Article 6(1)(a)) and PIPEDA.

2.4 Targeting/Advertising Cookies

These cookies are used to deliver relevant advertisements and track the effectiveness of ad campaigns. They may be set by us or third-party advertising networks.

Legal Basis: These cookies require your explicit consent under GDPR (Article 6(1)(a)) and PIPEDA.

3. Third-Party Cookies

We may allow third-party services, such as analytics providers or advertising networks, to set cookies on your device. These cookies are subject to the respective third-party privacy policies, and we encourage you to review them.

Examples of third-party tools we may use:

- Google Analytics (for website traffic analysis);

- Social media plugins (e.g., Facebook, LinkedIn).

 - Yandex.Metrika Opt-Out.
